WHAT SORTS OF THINGS DO SUCCESSFUL STUDENTS DO TO REVISE?

START YOUR REVISION EARLY!

- Complete past papers at home under timed conditions - ensure that you look over the mark schemes to make a note of what went well and what could be improved.**
- Look back at previous end of topic assessments and make suggestions for improvement to underperforming answers.
- Use the PLC checklists in each of the topic booklets to check your understanding and tailor your revision to areas that are coded "Red".
- Re-read each booklet and condense this down into a single "mind map" (each lesson is to be a single branch) using key trigger words and images.
- Create a "Poster" for each topic.
- Create flashcards for all the key terms within Business (at the back of each topic booklet)—ensure that you learn these.
- Complete online quizzes to test your knowledge.
- Put key concepts on Post-it notes and place these in an area where you revise.
